

Dr Marjaana Lahti-Koski from Finland is Health Director at Finnish Heart Association (since 2004) and Adjunct Professor in Public Health at Helsinki University (since 2009). Her past posts include e.g. Senior Researcher at National Public Health Institute, Finland (1995-2004) and Research Fellow (post doc) at University of Sydney (July 2002-June 2003).

Marjaana Lahti-Koski graduated in nutrition (MSc) from the University of Helsinki in 1990. Her PhD (public health, University of Helsinki) in 2001 was an epidemiological work on obesity among adults in Finland. She has publications in the field of obesity and public health nutrition, and memberships in several working groups, including Board Member of the Finnish Association for the Study of Obesity (2004-2010) and Member of EASO's Prevention and Public Health Task Force. She has been Board Member of National Nutrition Council since 2005 in Finland. FoP labelling (Heart Symbol) has been included in her work in one way or another since the late 1990's.
