Niels Riksen is a full professor of Vascular Medicine at the Radboud university medical centre in Nijmegen. After a PhD in 2007 on clinical pharmacology and ischemia-reperfusion injury and a postdoc period in the Hatter Cardiovascular Institute in London on myocardial ischemia-reperfusion injury, he was registered as an internist and specialist in vascular medicine in 2010 and became head of department of vascular medicine of the Radboud university medical center in 2012. In 2014 he was appointed full professor of Vascular Medicine.

In 2012 his research focus shifted towards the role of innate immune cells, in particular innate immune memory, in atherosclerosis. In recent years he published several papers on this topic in Cell, Cell Metabolism, Circulation, and the European Heart Journal.
