Rocco Barazzoni is Associate Professor of Internal Medicine at Trieste University, Italy, consultant in Internal Medicine and coordinator for the Obesity Outpatient Unit at Trieste University Hospital. He was General Secretary of ESPEN 2012-2016, and is the current ESPEN Chairman since the 2018 ESPEN Congress in Madrid. He is also co-chairman of the ESPEN Special Interest Group on Obesity, and previously member of the Italian Obesity Society (SIO) national Executive Board as well as head of SIO national Scientific Committee. He has participated in Editorial Boards of Diabetes, Current Opinion in Clinical Nutrition and Metabolism, Clinical Nutrition Experimental. His research focuses on nutritional and hormonal regulation of energy metabolism and mitochondrial function, oxidative stress, inflammation and insulin resistance in both clinical and experimental models in the settings of obesity, its metabolic complications and malnutrition. Professor Barazzoni has published more than 120 papers on these topics in international peer-reviewed journals, including original research as well as editorials, consensus and position papers and guidelines.
